



FISH FOR THE FUTURE

Rules & Regulations

The following rules apply to the 2018 Fish for the Future Derby:

1. All anglers must register with derby official on Friday, September 21st between 7:00am – 8:00pm to be eligible for prize winnings.
2. All anglers must have a valid tidal waters fishing license.
3. All anglers are strongly encouraged to use release nets. Nets may be available to rent.
4. All anglers must sign a waiver & release form at the time of registration.
5. A predetermined derby VHF channel will be released during the derby. All vessels are required to monitor it and channel 16 (Coast Guard) for safety purposes at all times.
6. The 2018 Fish for the Future Derby is a **catch and release** event only.
7. Each angler may weigh in as many fish as they want.
8. Weight will be determined by $((\text{length} \times \text{girth} \times \text{girth}) / 800)$ as measured by derby officials.
9. Anglers must be aware of and follow the British Columbia sport fishing rules and regulations.
10. All vessels must contact the weigh-in officials on designated VHF channel in order for their fish to be measured in a timely manner to avoid unnecessary handling of the fish. Keep fish in the water until weigh boat arrives
11. Weigh-in will close at 5:00 pm (PST) on Saturday, September 22nd and at 4:00pm (PST) on Sunday, September 23rd.
12. Any disputes will be subject to mediation by the derby officials.
13. Fishing zones map will be in your swag back at check in
14. Tie breaker Rules; if 2 fish have the same measurements the winner will be awarded based on the time of the fish was called in.
